




Structure of the Council

The Council consists of 3 Committees coordinated by the PERMSEC Staff.

Each committee consists the permanent members on a non-profit volunteers basis elected and acting 1 year.



Tasks

- Organization of educational events as a part of the World Summit of Nobel Peace Laureates (WSNPLs) as other events linked to youth;
- Interaction with academia, other NGOs and promotion of the Official Summit Youth Program "Leading by Example";
- Research work.

Goals

- Formation of a unique educational ecosystem on peacekeeping topics;
- Implementation of educational programs proposed by the members of the Council and PermSec;
- Development of topics and issues that are relevant to the global agenda;
- Providing a forum or any event organized by the PERMSEC with speakers;
- Building strong relationship with the organizations working in the same or related fields.



Membership conditions

Members of the Council have the right to:

- to take part in the preparation, discussion and decision-making on issues considered at the meeting of the Council's expert groups;
- to participate in the preparation and discussion of the Council's work plans;
- to submit proposals for consideration by the Council on consideration of certain issues within the competence of the Council in an unscheduled manner.

Members of the Council are obliged to:

- to participate in the meetings of the Council and its expert groups.
- to consider the materials proposed for discussion, prepare proposals and conclusions on them;
- to be objective and unbiased when considering issues at meetings;
- to carry out the tasks of the Council.

Any member of the Council has the right to resign from its membership by announcing his decision to the PermSec.

A member of the Council is considered retired from the date of approval of the application by the PermSec.

The PERMSEC President has the right to make a sole decision on the withdrawal of any of its members from the Council on the following grounds:

- Violation of the requirements of this Regulation;
- Systematic (more than three times in a row) absence from expert group meetings;
- Committing actions discrediting the activities of the Council.

The members of the Expert Council carry out their activities on a voluntary basis.



Selection criteria

A member of the Council:

- must be a representative of the academia;
- possess relevant knowledge, skills and competencies in accordance with the subject matter of the committee to which it belongs;
- have significant results in the implementation of practical projects, research and scientific;
- publications in the field of international law, peacemaking, human rights, sustainable development;
- have experience in speeches, analytics and expert evaluation;
- have experience working with young people.

Nomination and appointment process

A member of the Council is nominated by the academic partner as follows.

A member of the Council is appointed by the PermSec through a letter of appointment.

The term for which a member is appointed equals to 1 year.

The member can be re-appointed several consecutive times.



Committee 1: GR and NGOs cooperation

Tasks and goals:

- Promotion of the WSNPLs' youth program through interaction with NGOs and Foundations from the globe;
- The PERMSEC and academic partners networking development;
- Strengthening of the existing partnerships of PERMSEC with the academic partners;
- Involving of the potential new partners in PermSec activities and initiatives;
- Participation in world events as speakers on behalf of the PERMSEC.

Committee 2: The WSNPLs' Youth Program Committee

Tasks and goals:

- Elaboration of the agenda for all youth events organized by the PERMSEC;
- Proposals of the topics for PeaceLabs and workshops/NPLs' lectures as the events of the WSNPLs or as other events organized by the PERMSEC;
- Invitation of the new speakers for the WSNPLs youth program;
- Proposal and approval of the format of any educational events organized by the PERMSEC;
- Selection of the best youth projects and startups.



Committee 3: Research and Analytic Committee

Tasks and goals:

- Research work in the field of Peace: investigation of the new trends in the realm of Peace, proposals of the new topics to be discussed at the WSNPLs, investigation of the new speakers to be invited at the next WSNPLs;
- Elaboration of new methodological instructions and materials to be used by universities or other educational bodies to teach Peace;
- Enhancement of a unique educational ecosystem on peacekeeping developed by the PERMSEC;
- Assistance in implementation of educational projects proposed by other members of the Council;
- Promotion of PERMSEC educational activities and programs through participation in international events on behalf of the PERMSEC.
